CHILI COOK OFF RULES

1. No ingredients (including meat) may be precooked or treated in any way prior to the preparation period. The only exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beverages, broth, grinding or mixing spices/herbs.
2. The cooking period will be a minimum of 3 hours and a maximum of 4 hours. Contestants do not have to cook for the entire period if they choose not to. Setup begins at 11:00 A.M. Preparation and cooking may begin at 11:30 A.M., judging at 4:00 P.M. and serving the public at 5:00 P.M.
3. A chairperson will conduct a contestant meeting at 11:00 A.M. One member of each team must be present. Final instructions will be given and any questions will be answered.
4. Contestants will be responsible for supplying all their cooking utensils, etc.
5. The sponsors of the Chili Cook Off will provide an area for each team and a table. You **MUST** also bring a **CLEAN TARP** to place on the floor below your booth. **DO NOT PUT ANY DUCT TAPE** on the floor.
6. Contestants need to provide their own cooking stoves. (Camp Stoves: **WHITE GAS ONLY.**) **COOKING HAS TO BE DONE INDOORS AND ON WHITE GAS ONLY!!** Plywood will be provided for you to place under your cook stove; this will prevent the plastic table from melting.
7. Contestants will be permitted to set up their equipment, decorations, and other facilities anytime after 11:00 A.M. on the day of the Chili Cook Off.
8. Each team will consist of one chief cook and their assistants; please try to keep your assistants to a maximum of 4, but more is okay if needed.
9. Each team is required to prepare a minimum of 2 gallons of chili for judging and serving to the public.
10. The decision of the judges will be **FINAL!!**

Please make sure that you have picked up your spot!

Please be discreet when drinking alcohol. This is a family event.
