CHILI COOK OFF RULES

- 1. No ingredients (including meat) may be precooked or treated in any way prior to the preparation period. The only exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beverages, broth, grinding or mixing spices/herbs.**
- 2. The cooking period will be a minimum of 3 hours and a maximum of 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ hours. Contestants do not have to cook for the entire period if they choose not to. Setup begins at 10:00 A.M. Preparation and cooking may begin at 10:45 A.M. Judging is at 3:30 P.M. Serving the public begins at 5:00 P.M.**
- 3. A chairperson will conduct a contestant meeting at 10:45 A.M. One member of each team must be present. Final instructions will be given and any questions will be answered.**
- 4. Contestants will be responsible for supplying all their cooking utensils, etc.**
- 5. The sponsors of the Chili Cook Off will provide an area for each team and a table. You MUST also bring a CLEAN TARP to place on the floor below your booth. DO NOT PUT ANY DUCT TAPE on the floor.**
- 6. Contestants need to provide their own cooking stoves. (Camp Stoves: WHITE GAS ONLY.)**
- 7. Contestants will be permitted to set up their equipment, decorations, and other facilities anytime after 10:00 A.M. on the day of the Chili Cook Off.**
- 8. Each team will consist of 3 members. One chief cook and two assistants.**
- 9. Each team is required to prepare a minimum of 2 gallons of chili for judging. Not more than one quart of each contestant's chili will be collected at the end of the cooking period and taken to the judges for judging.**
- 10. The decision of the judges will be FINAL!!**

Please make sure that you have cleaned up your spot!

Please be discreet when drinking alcohol. This is a family event.
