A special meeting of the Chairman and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Arnold, Nebraska, was held in the Meeting Room at the Arnold Community Center on Monday, June 15, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. Notice of this meeting was given in advance by publication and by posting a notice on Facebook and at the following places: Pinnacle Bank, Post Office, Reeds Food Center, and the Village Office. The agenda for said meeting was on the posted notices. Notice of this meeting and an agenda was given to the Board Members and all members present acknowledged receipt of said notice. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

Due to the absence of Chairman Zach Hagler, Village Clerk Patricia Lamberty called the meeting to order. On roll call the following were present: Glen Bowers, Donnell DeLosh, Jason Jenkins, Austin Snyder. Absent: Zach Hagler. A quorum being present the following proceedings were had and done. Patricia Lamberty, Village Clerk, recorded the proceedings.

Patricia Lamberty informed the Board that due to the absence of Chairman Zach Hagler a Chairman Pro Tem needs to be appointed. Moved by Snyder and seconded by DeLosh to appoint Glen Bowers as Chairman Pro Tem. Roll call vote: Aye: Bowers, DeLosh, Jenkins, Snyder. Nay: none. Absent: Hagler. Motion carried.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairman Pro Tem Glen Bowers publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is available for public inspection and is posted on the west wall of the meeting room in the Arnold Community Center.

Patricia Lamberty, Village Clerk, informed the Board that 143.24 tons of tires were collected during Arnold's Scrap Tire Cleanup Event. After discussion, moved by DeLosh and seconded by Snyder to issue a check to Resource Management Company, Inc. for \$23,491.36 for tire disposal. Roll call vote: Aye: Bowers, DeLosh, Jenkins, Snyder. Nay: none. Absent: Hagler. Motion carried. Arnold was awarded a grant from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Grant Fund through the Nebraska Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (DWEE). Invoices for labor costs, advertising costs and hauler costs will be submitted to DWEE for reimbursement.

After discussion, moved by DeLosh and seconded by Jenkins to purchase the used volleyball net standards for the Community Center from the Arnold Public School for \$1,250.00. Roll call vote: Aye: Bowers, DeLosh, Jenkins, Snyder. Nay: none. Absent: Hagler. Motion carried. Eric Holmberg, Village Superintendent, informed the Board that the volleyball net that is currently at the Community Center will be relocated to the sand volleyball court at the Arnold Recreation Area.

After discussion, moved by Snyder and seconded by Jenkins to authorize Patricia Lamberty, Village Clerk, to issue a check to Tri State Paving for \$75,880.00 for Street Improvements (Chip Seal & Fog Seal) upon completion of the project. Roll call vote: Aye: Bowers, DeLosh, Jenkins, Snyder. Nay: none. Absent: Hagler. Motion carried.

Tom Werblow and Bernie Straetker, Professional Engineers, attended the meeting to discuss the proposed sidewalk improvements project. Cheryl Carson, Economic Development Director, and Brad Forrester also attended the meeting regarding the sidewalk improvements project.

Tom Werblow presented the project plans to the Board and reported all affected property owners had been contacted regarding the proposed improvements. The Board discussed various aspects of the project. Consideration of advertising for bids for sidewalk improvements on the 100 Block of South Walnut will be placed on the July 13th agenda.

There being nothing further to come before the Board at this time, Chairman Pro Tem Glen Bowers declared the meeting adjourned. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
